2. Our Commitment to Net Zero

ProviMediSupply Limited is fully committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions across our UK operations by 2050, in alignment with the UK Government's legally binding Net Zero target and NHS England's Net Zero ambitions set out in the Greener NHS Programme.

As a supplier of medical consumables, hygiene products, and facilities supplies to NHS and public sector healthcare organisations, we recognise our responsibility as part of the NHS supply chain to contribute to the collective effort to decarbonise healthcare procurement. We commit to measuring, reducing, and reporting our emissions in a transparent and consistent manner.

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been approved at Board level by Ade Olabode, Director of ProviMediSupply Limited, and is published on our company website at www.provimediasupply.co.uk. It will be reviewed and updated annually.

3. Baseline Emissions

As a newly established business (incorporated 2026), ProviMediSupply Limited has established its emissions baseline for the financial year 2025/26. Emissions have been calculated in accordance with the GHG Protocol Corporate Standard, using UK Government conversion factors (BEIS/DESNZ 2025).

Given our early stage of operation, our current emissions footprint is very low. We are a service-led, asset-light business operating primarily from a single office location in Hertfordshire. We do not operate heavy vehicles, manufacturing equipment, or energy-intensive facilities.

4.2 Procurement and Supply Chain Decarbonisation

As a healthcare supplies business, our most significant carbon lever is our supply chain (Scope 3b). We are committed to:

- Requesting Carbon Reduction Plans from all key product suppliers by December 2026
- Prioritising suppliers who can demonstrate lower-carbon manufacturing and logistics
- Selecting UK-based or European suppliers where equivalent quality and price are available, to reduce transport emissions
- Working with NHS Supply Chain sustainability frameworks and the Labour Standards Assurance System (LSAS) to ensure our supply chain meets ethical and environmental standards
- Including sustainability criteria in our supplier selection and annual review process from 2026/27 onwards

4.3 Sustainable Product Offering

We recognise that the products we supply can themselves have a sustainability impact on NHS trusts. We are committed to:

- Actively expanding our range of products with sustainable credentials (recyclable packaging, reduced plastic content, UK/European manufactured)
- Providing NHS customers with information on the environmental credentials of products we supply
- Supporting NHS trusts in meeting their own sustainability targets through product choice
- Removing products with unnecessary environmental impact from our catalogue as sustainable alternatives become available

5. Reporting and Review Commitment

5.1 Annual Reporting

ProviMediSupply Limited commits to publishing an updated Carbon Reduction Plan annually, each May, covering:

- Updated emissions data for the previous financial year
- Progress against reduction targets and initiatives
- Revised targets where necessary based on performance
- Expanded Scope 3 reporting as data availability improves
